

dialoguing difference: call for papers

We invite graduate students, advanced undergraduate students, and faculty to submit work on issues on and related to women of color feminism, as well as work on and around difference and identity/-ies. Papers, performances, and/or panels might focus on any number of the following, though in no way is limited to:

- The histories and relationships between women of color, their scholarship and disciplinarity
- Intersections of women of color scholarship and queer theory or queer of color critique
- Exploring the methodological and pedagogical practices of women of color scholars and educators
- Theorizing advancements in cultural, political and social theory that fall under the umbrella of women of color theory
- Examining the conversation about the state of women of color feminism and the politics of women of color coalition work

The purpose of this symposium is to gather emerging and established women of color scholars, as well as scholars whose work engages in similar methodological, epistemological, and pedagogical practices. The conference participants will share their work in a safe and supportive space, engendering specific arguments and interventions via critiques through difference.
