- If you choose to copyright, you must do so independently through the **U.S. Copyright Office of the Library of Congress**. You may phone them at (202) 707 – 3000, or visit their website at, www.copyright.gov for further information.

INFORMATION FOR THE DOCTORAL DISSERTATION ONLY

- Copyright privileges reside with you immediately upon creation of your work. Registration of your copyright establishes a public record of your dissertation and confers additional legal rights.
- For a **\$65 Fee**, ProQuest (UMI Dissertation Publishing) will file, on your behalf, an application for registration of a claim of copyright for your dissertation. This service is **AVAILABLE ONLY FOR AUTHORS PUBLISHING THEIR ENTIRE DISSERTATIONS WITH PROQUEST**. - Doctoral candidates choosing to publish the **Only The Abstract** may copyright their dissertations by following the instructions for the Master's thesis.
